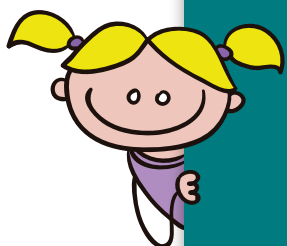

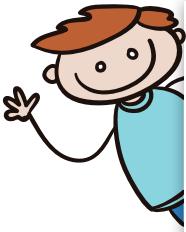

- Awards evening: **14 September**, at Aurora Centre, Burnside High School

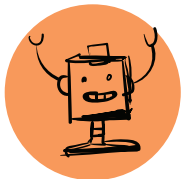
There are five key categories:



Movie Making: Demonstrate how handy you are behind the camera! Your movie, documentary, report, or digital story should be no more than 3 minutes and demonstrate excellent camera-work, editing, dialogue or narration, plus background music to enhance the story.



Website Creation: Develop a website that explains, explores or encourages positive change. Be original in your concept, content and design. Your website can contain a range of media including blogs, video, polls, etc.



Digital Sandpit: Play in a digital sandpit - explore robotics, coding, app development, games, digital worlds and the maker culture. This category has been created for innovative kids to show off their latest digital creations and to share knowledge.



Green Screen: If you want to see change in the world but don't have a ticket to travel, move characters or people around in a world that is projected onto a green screen. This could be a future or past world, use your imagination to create a world you would love to be a part of.



Digital Art: Using a digital art form, such as graphic design, digital photos, animation, comics or a photostory, display good composition, emotion and digital techniques.
